SECTION 3

FEDERAL AIRBORNE HUNTING ACT

I, the cooperator, give my consent to the Department of Agriculture, APHIS, to utilize information contained on this form, and other information related to the aerial hunting program, so that this agency can comply with the required provisions of the Federal Airborne Hunting Act and the Privacy Act.

SECTION 4

I, the cooperator, have been informed of the methods and the manner in which APHIS will conduct activities for the purpose of stopping or preventing wildlife caused damage, and of the hazards associated with aerial hunting related activities. I also understand that APHIS, again to include its officers and employees, cooperators, and agents, will exercise reasonable precaution under APHIS supervision to safeguard all persons and to prevent injury to animal life other than those listed in Section 2 (C) above; guard against mishandling of the control devices and materials, and exercise due caution and judgment in all related control operations.

SECTION 5

In consideration of these understandings and the benefits to be derived, I, the cooperator, agree to take reasonable precautions to prevent injury to livestock and other domestic animals, assume responsibility for injury to my property, or to property under my control, not due to the negligence of APHIS; assist in maintaining such warning signs as APHIS may place for the purpose of notifying persons entering on such lands of the hazards associated with the wildlife damage management measures in use thereon; and to give warning to persons I authorize to enter upon such lands of these same hazards.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS

This agreement may be revoked by either party by a 30-day written notice.

DISTRICT COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into by the Natchitoches Soil & Water Conservation District, referred to hereinafter as the "District", and

THE DISTRICT AGREES TO:

Assist in carrying out a natural resource conservation plan or objective by furnishing to the Cooperator such (1) information, (2) technical assistance and supervision, and (3) other assistance as it may have available at the time the work is to be done.

THE COOPERATOR AGREES TO:

1. Use his land within its capabilities.
2. Treat his land in keeping with its needs.
3. Develop as rapidly as feasible a conservation plan for his entire unit or tract.
4. Start applying one or more conservation practices in keeping with these objectives and the technical standards of the District.
5. Maintain all structures established in an effective condition, and to continue the use of all other conservation measures put into effect.
6. Use any materials or equipment made available to him by the District for the purpose and in the manner provided for it.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED THAT:

1. this agreement will become effective on the date of the last signature and may be terminated or modified by mutual agreement of parties hereto.
2. The provisions of this agreement are understood by the Cooperator and the District, and neither shall be liable to damage to the others property resulting from carrying out this agreement unless such damage is caused by negligence or misconduct.

DISTRICT COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT – ADDENDUM I**

**NOTICE: Feral Swine-Natural Resource Damage Management Program
Fee for Service**

Program Participation Criteria: Natchitoches Parish landowners may participate in the Feral Swine Natural Resource Damage Management program according to the following priorities and guidelines:

1. USDA/APHIS deems the property to be within sufficient proximity to a NWR or other targeted area to enhance the desired effect of natural resource protection and enhancement.
2. Landowner acknowledges the service is FREE of charge per acre regardless of land-use, land-cover or timber type of contracted area.
3. Landowner agrees to enroll _____ acres in program by December 20, 2022. If signed form is not received by the set date, then the landowners acreage will not be enroll.
4. Signatory partners of, and participants of activities authorized and conducted through this Cooperative Service Agreement, agree to indemnify and hold harmless the district, from and against any and all loss, damage, liability, claims, demands or suits of any nature whatsoever, including costs and attorney’s fees asserted by attendees or third persons and arising out of, or which are alleged to arise out of, activities conducted through this agreement. This indemnity shall apply regardless of whether said loss, damage, liability, claims, demands or suits are occasioned in whole or in part by presumed negligence of the district, its supervisors, employees or servants of any kind, or its cooperators.

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
